The **PORTIMÃO TROPHY/IBERIAN CUP 2010** for the class of Formula Windsurfing will be held in the Praia da Rocha, Portimão, from 01 to 04 of April, 2010.

The Organising Authority will be the CLUBE NAVAL PORTIMÃO with the collaboration of the Portuguese Federation, the Real Spanish Federation, the Portuguese Formula Association and the Spanish Formula Association.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by:
 - (a) The rules as defined in the ISAF Windsurfing Competition Rules (WCR)1.
 - (b) The Formula Windsurfing Class Rules.
- 1.2. National prescriptions shall not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Competitors must comply with the ISAF Regulation 19, Eligibility Code.
- 2.2. Competitors with Portuguese nationality or with legal residence in Portugal shall also comply with the eligibility prescriptions of the Federação Portuguesa de Vela.

3. ADVERTISING


- 3.1. ISAF Regulation 20 Advertising Code applies.
- **3.2.** In accordance with ISAF Regulation 20, boats shall display at all times a sticker with the event sponsor advertising, if provided by the Organising Authority.

6. ENTRIES

8. COMPETITORS REGISTRATION

- **8.1** Each competitor must sign personally the Registration Form at the Race Office from 10.00 to 13.00 on 01 April of 2010.
- **8.2.** Registration is subject to the presentation of the following documents:
 - (a) Sailor Federation licences (Portuguese sailors only).
 - (b) Third party liability insurance covering a minimum amount of 300.000,00 euros, or Sailor Federation Licences.
- 8.3. Documents and sailing instructions can be collected from 10.00 hours to 13.00, on the first day of the event, from the Race Office after fulfilling the requirements mentioned above.

9.2. Competition format:

Fleet races will be sailed. If more than 80 entries received they may sail in 2 groups. A minimum of 3 races must be completed to validate the event. The maximum races of the event will be 12 races. Two races in the first and last day, and four races in the second and third day. In the four day, the last possible race, will be held at 16.00.

Boats, sails, rigging and crews must be at the disposal of the Equipment Inspectors at their respective parking from 10.00 hours to 13.00 hours on 01/04 2010. An Equipment Registration Form must be submitted before the start of racing.

Attention is drawn to Fundamental Rule 4, Decision to Race, RRS Part 1 which establishes: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".

Travel

The near airport is the International Faro airport, and is 60 km from the place were the event will take place Portimão – Praia da Rocha. Between Faro airport and Portimão is a high way.

The Clube Naval de Portimão, have a car to take the equipment and the windsurfer guy from Faro to Portimão, in the days 31 of March, and in the morning of 01 of April. Only have to send a email or a fax to the club to inform when the flight arrive to the airport, and the name of the person.

In the end of the event, the organizer club has also a car to take the people and equipment to the airport, only have to tell the secretary-reception of the event, in the first day, to know when the date and hour of the flight, to arrange everything.
